Mandatory Requirements for Coaches

- All coaches to have a clear DBS check, complete on-line Safeguarding and Emergency Aid courses prior to any involvement with a team. **This is non-negotiable.** The sooner the DBS check is completed, and on-line courses are completed the sooner you can help with a team.
- All parent / helper / assistance referee also needs to have a clear DBS check and complete on-line Safeguarding course prior to any involvement with a team.
- Course details will be shared by Club Welfare Officer upon clear DBS check being obtained.
- Each coach / parent / helper to hold a FAN number (only one please) so courses can be tracked via the FA system.
- Club will cover costs associated with DBS check and on-line courses.

Mandatory Requirements for Coaches (cont.)

- Each team to have a minimum of one coach who holds a Level 1 / Introduction to Coaching Football qualification. **This is non-negotiable.**
- Each coach to completed emergency contact / medical issue summary for their team. Club secretary to provide document template. Summary document to be kept in the team's First Aid bag.
- First Aid bag to be taken to every training session and match.
- Any First Aid items used can be replenished - spares are kept in the Colts Matchday Cupboard.
- Each team to have a designated respect monitor at each match. Respect monitor is required to wear respect monitor bib during each match.
